An Important Message About Your Huntingdon E-mail Account

Your Huntingdon e-mail account is something that you can take with you when you graduate! As long as you continue to actively use your account, either with Thunderbird/Outlook or via Webmail, you can keep your account.

We check accounts every six months for activity, so if your account has not been used for more than six months, it will be removed. Also, please do not forward your account to another e-mail account. Your account needs to be actively used to not be removed.

Young Alumni



We invite you, as one of Huntingdon's Young Alumni, to join the Huntingdon Society, the College's most elite donor group. For the first ten years after your graduation date, you can become a member of the Huntingdon Society with an annual gift of \$500 or more to the Huntingdon Fund.
